A Message from Fr. Kubista:

As a pastor who really cares about people especially those in my parish, I feel obligated that I must say something about the so called “vaccine” (the jab) especially since I have grave concerns about it. I know some have taken it and others have not. I will not take it under any circumstance. We should not let this issue cause division but rather it should be a situation where we rally together to do what is best for all of us.

Since God entrusted us all with proper care of our body, if any of us believe that something will harm us, we have an obligation to resist that harm. There is evidence that the jab is very harmful even deadly. Currently in the Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS), there are over 16,309 deaths (more deaths than all previous vaccines combined), over 23,711 who are permanently disabled, and many other adverse events. (A Harvard study said that VAERS only reports 1% of the actual adverse events.) Dr. Peter McCullough, a medical safety expert, says the jab is way over the necessary conditions to stop its use... it should have been shut down in February... individuals who have pushed it, are guilty of malfeasance [violating moral and/or civil law]...if you look through records of all the patients who have died, they were all inadequately treated.¹ Dr. McCullough says that *“the disability that we are going to see due to these vaccines will go down in history as an unbelievable atrocity.”* Dr. Robert Malone, the inventor of the mRNA technology used in the jab, says we should *“pause it”...“it is an insane push to vaccinate”...“it is creating a situation which we are breeding superbugs”* ².

There are other things which should raise our concern. The jab technology is new which Dr. Malone says it is “gene therapy applied to vaccines”. The jab hijacks our cells to make the spike protein which Dr. McCullough says by itself is a deadly protein and it is the first time we are instructing our bodies to make it. The jab is an experimental drug and all those who take it are part of the clinical trial. The deaths due to COVID 19 virus have been inflated. In March the CDC reported that of the reported COVID 19 virus deaths, 94% of them had an average of 3.8 comorbidities, in other words the virus put them over the threshold. The inflated numbers have created a greater sense of fear in the population, moving the population to be more open to take the jab. Our government is mandating the jab, which is a violation of human rights, and is causing people to be threatened with or actually losing their job, adding more pressure for them to get the jab. Religious exemptions are being denied which violates religious liberty.

Dr. Malone says that what was done with the jab was *“grossly naive, rushed out, and absolutely not consistent with the policies and procedures and rules(federal law)” necessary for approval; “they have thrown away the rule book”...“the entire HHS system has been corrupted”...“the media and government are corrupted”* One example is that the FDA seemed deceptive when it approved Comirnaty, which apparently is not going to be available until 2023, but continued the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for the jab. One reason for keeping the jab under the EUA is that anyone associated with the jab are not liable for any ill consequences from it, people who get the jab have no legal recourse.

Dr. Malone says *“we know natural immunity is up to at least 20 times more effective and definitely more durable than immunity conferred on by jab.”* God knew from the beginning of the world, the moment He created Adam and Eve, that COVID 19 would occur and God must have protected us from it by putting safeguards in our immune system. We are to pray for one another, put our trust in God, and support our immune system to the best of our ability. God bless you.
